Components of a Complete Application

Any application submitted has to meet the following Legal and Statutory requirements

1. Copy or certificate of registration, including proof of operation
2. Copy of the Constitution/Charter or Statutes of your organization.
3. Copy of CR12
4. Curriculum vitae of designated representative(s) of the organization.
5. Provide financial reports for the last 2 years
6. Activity reports in the specific thematic area
7. Provide proof of key achievement/concrete indicators
8. Provide names and contact details of three (3) references who can support your application (Clients that you serve/partners etc)

Focus Areas

TuiFUND will consider enterprises working towards addressing one or more of the sustainable development goals.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to be eligible for the grant, applicants must:

1. Be a social enterprise organization registered under the relevant Laws of Kenya.
2. Have been registered for not less than 2 years.
3. Be directly responsible for the preparation and management of any proposed project, i.e. not acting as an intermediary.
4. Implement the Program/Initiative in Kenya.
5. Propose a project that is innovative and Social impact-driven.
6. Propose a program whose duration should be within a maximum of 12 months.
7. All proposed Project start dates should not be earlier than grant award **date**.

Ineligibility

We will not consider the following for funding:

Individuals or organizations

That are discovered to have mismanaged other grants or funds received in the past from institutions, or their subsidiaries and affiliates Organizations that advocate, promote, or espouse inhumane policies, illegal activities and/or terrorism.

That have legal proceedings initiated against them.
